



BEST CONDITION SCORES HIGH POINT AWARD CRITERIA

Equestrian Canada is pleased to announce an annual Best Condition Scores – High Point Award. The Best Condition Scores - High Point will be presented to the horse that has accumulated the most points from the Best Condition judging at endurance rides throughout the year. At every Equestrian Canada recognized ride (50 mi / 80km or longer) horses presenting for Best Condition are scored and the points earned will be forwarded by the Ride Manager to Equestrian Canada. At year end, these points will be added up and the horse with the highest total from all rides will be declared the winner. We hope that this will encourage more riders to participate in Best Condition judging. A horse who consistently achieves Top Ten, or scores quite well in a number of rides could be a contender for this award. Horses must be enrolled in the Equestrian Canada Endurance database and the owner must be a member of Equestrian Canada.
