

## **ARABIAN JUDGES**

## **1 PROMOTION**

All applications for Arabian judge status must be made on the Arabian application form available from the EC National Office and must be submitted to the National Office. All applications will be reviewed by Equestrian Canada. The applicant will be advised in writing by the EC National Office as to the results.

## 2 RECORDED

Applicants for Recorded Arabian judge status must:

- 1. Be an EC Gold sport license holder in good standing;
- 2. Submit a personal resume detailing the applicant's equine experience as owner, breeder, trainer, competitor, competition manager;
- 3. Act as a learner judge with an EC Senior/Senior National or USEF Registered Arabian judge listed on their current AHA Official's Roster, at a minimum of two EC/USEF regular competitions in the Arabian Horse Division; and must obtain letters of recommendation from these two EC Senior/Senior National or USEF Registered Arabian judges which must accompany the application;
- 4. Have attended an Arabian Horse Division judges evaluation;
- 5. Provide the names and addresses of three or more individual references all of whom must be EC/USEF individual senior members;
- 6. Write the EC Arabian Judge's Test which is available from the EC National Office and obtain the required passing score.

Note: Test will be given to the applicant when all other requirements are met.

## **3 SENIOR**

Applicants for Senior Arabian judge status must:

- 1. Be an EC senior license holder in good standing;
- 2. Hold an EC Recorded judges card in the Arabian Horse Division prior to being approved for Senior judges status in the Arabian Horse Division;
- 3. Have acted as a recorded judge for the complete Arabian Division at a minimum of five EC/USEF competitions. Of the seven EC/USEF competitions worked. (two competitions as a learner judge and five competitions as a recorded judge in the Arabian Division), four competitions must be an EC/USEF All-Arabian competition. Recorded judging in foreign countries will be accepted provided a letter is signed by the senior judge or show steward verifying attendance and accompanies the application;
- 4. Submit a list of competitions at which she/he worked as a recorded judge in the Arabian Horse Division; a list of the classes worked in each competition; if possible the number of horses in each class; and the names and addresses of the senior judge(s);
- 5. Submit five letters of recommendation from EC Senior/Senior National or USEF Registered Arabian judges listed on their current Official's Roster with whom the applicant acted as a recorded judge (not learner judge experiences) in the Arabian Horse Division in the above noted five EC/USEF competitions;
- 6. Have attended an Arabian Horse Division judges evaluation;



7. write the EC Arabian Judge's Test which is available from the EC National Office and obtain the required passing score 90%.

NOTE: Test will be given to the applicant when all other requirements are met.

- 8. EC Senior Arabian judges who are recognized Arabian judges by the Arabian Horse Association and listed in the Annual AHA Arabian Judge's Directory will be granted EC Senior National status
- 9. EC Arabian judges may judge non-rated competitions in the Breed Sport divisions for which they are qualified as independent contractors and not covered by the protection of the EC official's license.
