If the rider and pony/horse are led, the leader should have minimal influence on the pony/horse or rider. The amount of influence provided by the leader will be reflected in the marks. One mark will be deducted from the movement score on each occasion that the leader is seen to influence the horse/pony. The leader should lead from the inside, changing sides in front of the pony at the halt movement.
