

PARA-DRESSAGE JUDGE

Dressage Judges may apply for an equivalent Para-Dressage status. For example, a Medium Dressage Judge can apply to become a Medium Para-Dressage Judge.

All applications for Para-Dressage status must be made on the application form available from Equestrian Canada and must be submitted to Equestrian Canada – Officials Programs along with any required documents by April 30th of the year of application. The applicant will be advised in writing by Equestrian Canada as to the results.

1 PROMOTION

Applicants for Para-Dressage judge status must:

- 1. Hold an EC Gold Sport License and be a member in good standing of EC.
- 2. Be a current Dressage judge.
- 3. Submit a personal resume detailing the applicant's equine experience.
- 4. Attend an EC Para judges' clinic or an FEI Para-Dressage judges' clinic and pass any required exams.

2 MAINTAINING STATUS

- 1. Para-Dressage Judges must meet the following requirements annually:
 - a. Hold an EC Gold Sport License and be a member in good standing of EC.
 - b. Be a current Dressage Judge.
- 2. Para-Dressage Judges must meet the following requirements once every three years:
 - a. Attend an EC Para clinic or an FEI Para-Dressage clinic.
 - b. Pass any required exams.

Failure to meet the maintenance requirements will result in the removal of the EC official status. Individuals who have had their status removed must re-apply for their status in accordance with the application rules.
