

PARA-EQUESTRIAN CLASSIFIERS

1 PROMOTION

Applicants must:

- 1. Be a member in good standing of Equestrian Canada.
- 2. Submit a personal resume detailing Physiotherapist and/or Medical training and any experience in Equestrian sport to Equestrian Canada.
- 3. Attend and complete all requirements of an Equestrian Canada accredited Para-Equestrian classifier course.
- 4. Submit three completed athlete classification bench tests for assessment to Equestrian Canada within one year of taking the Equestrian Canada Para-Equestrian Classifier course.

2 MAINTAINING STATUS

To maintain the status as an Equestrian Canada Para-Equestrian Classifier, individuals must meet the following requirements.

- 1. Annually:
 - a. Hold an Equestrian Canada Membership or Sport License and be a member in good standing at EC.
 - b. Be a member of Para-Equestrian Canada.
 - c. Keep up to date with EC and FEI rules, processes and changes.
- 2. Once every 2 years:
 - a. Attend a Para-Equestrian Classification seminar.
 - b. Show evidence of practical commitment by attending a national Event as Classifier or submitting 4 cards to the PE head Classifier every two years (as stated by the FEI).

Failure to meet the maintenance requirements will result in the removal of EC Para-Equestrian classifier status. Individuals who have had their status removed must re-apply in accordance with the application rules. It is also the responsibility of the classifier to have the appropriate level of insurance to perform their role.
