



ELITE AWARD NOMINATION FORM

Criteria

We would like to identify and honour any ELITE horse that has demonstrated an outstanding record of accomplishments during its career. This includes distance totals of at least 4800km (3000 mi), and several 160km (100 mi) rides. The horse's career may be over, or still ongoing, as long as the requirements have been met.

The following conditions must be met for this award:

1. The current owner must be a member in good standing of Equestrian Canada
2. The horse must be enrolled in the Equestrian Canada database
3. The horse may have been born in another country, but must currently be owned by a Canadian
4. At the start of its career, the horse conformed to the age restrictions in the Equestrian Canada rules
5. To count for mileage, completed rides must have been sanctioned by an appropriate Equestrian Canada recognized Provincial, National or International organization, including FEI. The rides may be from any country if the mileage can be verified.
6. The horse must have completed at least one Equestrian Canada sanctioned ride
7. The horse must have amassed a total of 4800km (3000 mi) in endurance distances of 80km (50 mi) or greater. Limited Distance, Set Speed and similar rides do NOT count. Competitive Trail miles also do not count.
8. The mileage:
 - a. Must have been accumulated over at least 10 years
 - b. Must include a minimum of 240km (150 mi) per year
 - c. Must include a minimum of 5 rides with distances of 160km (100 mi) or equivalent (such as a 2 day 120km)
9. Distance may be accumulated with any rider, of any age or nationality including, but not limited to, the current owner
10. A completed application must be returned for consideration by December 1st, to Equestrian Canada ATT: Endurance Awards (endurancecommittee@equestrian.ca)
