



## UNDER 25 SERIES CRITERIA

### 1. Eligible athletes

- Athletes are eligible from the beginning of the year in which they turn 16 to the end of the year in which they turn 25.
- Athletes who have competed on any Senior Nation's Cup Team are still eligible.

### 2. Declaration

- All athletes wishing to be considered are required to declare as a horse/athlete combination through the following portal: <https://licence.equestrian.ca/juu25/>
- Deadline to declare is **April 30** of the calendar year.
- Athletes may declare more than one horse.
- In the case of a horse being made available to an athlete after the deadline to form a new horse/athlete combination, the Youth Advisor and Discipline Manager may at their sole discretion declare this horse/athlete combination as a valid candidate for the U25 Series.

### 3. Specifications for competitions that qualify for ranking points

- Only FEI classes equal to or greater than 1.40M in height will be used.

### 4. Results

- The cut off date for results is **September 30** of the calendar year.
- Results will be tracked via the FEI U25 Ranking list:

### 5. U25 National Championship

Up to a maximum of five (5) horse/athlete combinations based on U25 results will be invited to enter the FEI CSI2\* competition at the EC National Championships as follows:

- Up to a maximum of five (5) Canadian U25 athletes.
- Athletes must be listed on the FEI U25 Rankings.
- Athletes are only eligible to ride one declared U25 horse in the FEI CSI2\* competition.
- Athletes are responsible for submitting their entries to the FEI CSI2\* competition by the competition given deadline.



FEI CSI2\* Classes:

- Class 121 Welcome
- Class 122 FEI 2\* Grand Prix (FEI ART 238.2.2)

The highest ranking U25 horse/athlete combination over both classes in the FEI CSI2\* competition at the EC National Championships will be declared the U25 National Champion.

In the event of a tie for the overall U25 National Champion, the horse/athlete combination with the highest placing in the Grand Prix will be awarded the title.
