Ben Asselin

Birthplace: Calgary, Alberta

Birthdate: April 13, 1994

Hometown: Calgary, Alberta

As the son of Nancy Southern, whose family owns the world-renowned show jumping venue Spruce Meadows, and Canadian Olympian Jonathan Asselin, it is no surprise that Ben Asselin has followed in his family's footsteps. His older sister, Kelly Koss-Brix, is also a show jumping trainer.

Experiencing success at an early age, Ben won the silver medal at the 2006 FEI Children's International Jumping Final for riders aged 12 to 14. As a junior, Ben posted a perfect score of five clear rounds riding Lolita to win the individual gold medal at the 2010 North American Junior Championship, having also led Alberta to the team gold.

In 2012, Ben made his Canadian Show Jumping Team debut as a member of the Nations' Cup team in Buenos Aires, Argentina. The following year, he won the \$205,000 Encana Cup riding Makavoy to earn his first victory in the International Ring at the Spruce Meadows 'Masters' tournament. In 2014, again riding Makavoy, Ben led Canada to its second win in the history of the BMO Nations' Cup at the Spruce Meadows 'Masters' tournament.

Having spent several years training in Germany with the legendary Ludger Beerbaum, Ben is one of Canada's most exciting young talents. His current string of top international mounts includes Veyron, The Freshman, and Luikan Q.

Erynn Ballard

Birthplace: Oakville, Ontario

Birthdate: September 13, 1980

Hometown: Tottenham, Ontario

Erynn Ballard began riding at the age of five with her parents, David and Sandi Ballard, and entered the show ring one year later. Equally talented in the hunter, jumper, and equitation divisions, Ballard became the second Canadian to win the prestigious ASPCA Maclay National Championship at the 1998 National Horse Show at New York City's Madison Square Garden. The following year, she captured the individual gold medal at the 1999 North American Young Riders' Championship riding Leacock.

Ballard made her Nations' Cup debut at the 2006 Spruce Meadows 'Masters' tournament, helping Canada win for the first time in the event's history, and was named the 2006 Equestrian Canada "Equestrian of the Year." She made her major games debut at the 2018 World Equestrian Games in Tryon, NC, riding Darkos Promise and, one year later, represented Canada at the 2019 Pan American Games in Lima, Peru, riding Fellini S.

Having long been the professional trainer and coach for her family's business, Looking Back Farm, Ballard now rides a multitude of horses for U.S. based sales barn, Ilan Ferder Stables. This successful partnership resulted in Ballard beginning the 2022 season as the number one female in the Longines World Rankings.

Elizabeth Bates

Birthplace: Toronto, Ontario

Birthdate: March 18, 1989

Hometown: Toronto, Ontario

Elizabeth “Liz” Bates followed in her older sister’s footsteps and began riding as a young girl. By the age of six, she was competing on the Trillium circuit in Ontario. She has worked with a variety of trainers as her career has progressed including Jane Casselman, Mark Hayes, Ainsley Vince, Leslie Howard, and Yann Candele.

Bates got her first taste of team competition at the 2010 North American Young Riders’ Championship in Lexington, KY, riding Marvelous 6. In 2015, she made headlines by winning the \$35,000 Brookstreet Grand Prix at the Ottawa International show jumping tournament riding Wildfire, a horse her older sister had purchased as a yearling at auction. The following year, Bates moved to Europe and has approximately one dozen horses at her Breakaway Equestrian training base in Nivelles, Belgium, including her own competition horses and sales prospects.

In 2019, Bates made her Canadian Show Jumping Team debut in the €100,000 Nations’ Cup held at CSIO4*-W Rabat in Morocco with her top horse, Chronos 31, who she recently sold to the U.S. She is currently developing Coach 11, purchased as a six-year-old, as well as Dede 5, Heartbreak 5, and I’m Special.

Bates holds a Bachelor of Science honours degree with a double major in psychology and political science from the University of Toronto. A former competitive gymnast, Bates loves working out and enjoys boxing and outdoor running to stay fit.

Lisa Carlsen

Birthplace: North York, Ontario

Birthdate: February 17, 1965

Hometown: Okotoks, Alberta

Lisa Carlsen won the individual gold medal at the 1984 North American Young Riders' Championship and made her Nations' Cup debut the following year at the Washington International Horse Show. Partnered with Kahlua, considered one of the greatest horses in Canadian show jumping history, Carlsen won several major grand prix events to earn a place at the 1987 Pan American Games in Indianapolis, Indiana, where Canada claimed the team gold medal and Carlsen placed sixth individually. The following year, the pair made their Olympic debut at the 1988 Seoul Olympic Games before Kahlua was retired from competition in 1990.

Carlsen remained in the international spotlight riding La Boom, her mount for Nations' Cup events in Buenos Aires, Argentina, in 2010 and the 2012 Nations' Cup Promotional League Final in Barcelona, Spain. Partnered with Parette, she served as the traveling alternate for the 2018 World Equestrian Games in Tryon, North Carolina, before representing Canada at the 2018 Nations' Cup Final in Barcelona and the 2019 Pan American Games in Lima, Peru.

Married to Dayton Gorsline, Carlsen operates Trademark Stables in Okotoks, Alberta. The couple has one daughter, Cassie Gorsline, 20, who is following in her parents' footsteps as a show jumping competitor.

Mac Cone

Birthplace: Memphis, Tennessee

Birthdate: August 23, 1952

Hometown: King, Ontario

Having competed at the international level for more than four decades, Mac Cone has represented both the U.S. and Canadian Equestrian Teams. Following early beginnings training under the legendary Bert de Nemethy, the Memphis native moved north of the border after marrying Canadian horsewoman Brenley Carpenter in 1979.

Riding Elute in his Olympic debut, Cone was the highest-placed Canadian rider at the 1996 Atlanta Olympic Games. It was a feat he would repeat at the 2002 World Equestrian Games in Jerez, Spain, riding Cocu. With Melinda, he was a member of Canada's silver medal team at the 2007 Pan American Games in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil. In his second Olympic appearance at the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games, this time riding Ole, Cone made history as a member of the Canadian team that won the silver medal following a thrilling jump-off for the gold against the United States.

His current top mounts are Con Couleur and Zaia Di San Giovanni, his partner for victory in the \$217,000 Major League Show Jumping Grand Prix at CSI5* Angelstone The International in Rockwood, ON, in 2021.

Cone operates Southern Ways Stable in Aurora, ON. A respected coach, Cone trained 1986 World Champion Gail Greenough as well as 2003 Pan American Games competitor and long-time student, Mark Samuel.

Mario Deslauriers

Birthplace: Venise en Quebec, Quebec **Birthdate:** February 23, 1965

Hometown: New York, New York

Mario Deslauriers began riding as a child at Bromont Equestrian Centre, site of the 1976 Olympic Games equestrian competition, under the tutelage of his father, Roger Deslauriers. In 1984 at the age of 19, Mario became the first Canadian and the youngest rider to ever win the World Cup Final, a record he still holds today. At the 1984 Los Angeles Olympics, he finished fourth with Aramis following a three-way jump-off for the individual bronze medal.

A two-time Canadian Show Jumping Champion, Mario has represented Canada at every major international event. In 2006, he was a member of the Canadian Team that scored its first victory in the \$350,000 BMO Nations' Cup at Spruce Meadows in Calgary, AB. With the opportunity to ride for an American owner, Mario began representing the United States in international competition in 2009. In 2017, he returned to ride for Canada and represented his birth country at the 2018 World Equestrian Games in Tryon, NC, the 2019 Pan American Games in Lima, Peru, and the 2020 Olympic Games in Tokyo, Japan, where he was Canada's sole individual.

Married to former U.S. Team member, Lisa Tarnopol, Mario and their twins, Jack and Lucy, reside in New York, NY, and Wellington, FL. Mario trains and competes alongside Lucy who, similar to his own career path, is enjoying incredible success at a young age and represented the U.S. at the 2019 Pan American Games.

Darrin Dlin

Birthplace: Edmonton, Alberta

Birthdate: March 2, 1970

Hometown: Calgary, Alberta

Alberta native Darrin Dlin rocketed onto the Canadian show jumping scene in 2007. With impressive results during the winter circuit in his then hometown of Wellington, FL, Dlin made the decision to spend the summer season in Canada. The decision paid off when he led the victory gallop for the \$70,000 World Cup Grand Prix Jumping du Quebec in Blainville, QC, and, one month later, claimed the \$100,000 World Cup Grand Prix in Palgrave, ON, riding Catwalk, a Canadian-bred mare sired by Rio Grande.

His results in Canadian World Cup qualifying competition, earned Dlin an invitation to the 2008 World Cup Final in Goteborg, Sweden, where he made his debut riding for Canada in international competition.

Having been based in Wellington, FL, for several years, Dlin returned home to his native Alberta in the spring of 2009. He is currently contesting the grand prix ranks with two horses, Dorado and Buddy Bounce. Following a successful 2021 season, Dlin and Buddy Bounce were named to the 2022 National Team Program for Jumping.

Dlin operates his training business out of Timberlea Farms in Okotoks, AB. He has one son, Aidan.

Ever since her parents gave her a rocking horse for her second Christmas Tiffany Foster's life has included horses. She began taking lessons at the age of eight and eventually began training with Brent and Laura Balisky in Langley, BC. Under their guidance, Foster had the distinction of winning both the Running Fox CET Medal and the Jump Canada Medal at the 2001 Royal Horse Show in Toronto, ON.

In 2006, Foster began working for Canadian Olympic Champion Eric Lamaze. She exploded onto the international show jumping scene in 2011, making her Canadian Show Jumping Team debut aboard Southwind VDL in the \$350,000 BMO Nations' Cup at the Spruce Meadows 'Masters' tournament. She has since made more than 45 Nations' Cup appearances for Canada including in Olympic, World Championship, and Pan American Games competition. In 2015, Foster helped Canada claim the team gold medal on home soil at the Pan American Games in Toronto, ON, riding Tripple X III. A year later at the 2016 Rio Olympic Games, the pair were members of Canada's fourth-placed team.

Foster's international training business, Little Creek Equestrian, has bases in Langley, British Columbia; Wellington, Florida; and Vrasene, Belgium.

He quickly found success on whichever horses happened to be in the field at the time and eventually took on training and coaching as his full-time profession. He credits his father's love of horses and his own passion for the sport of show jumping for getting him to where he is today.

Ifko is currently based outside of Calgary, AB, at Eventyre Farms. Owned by his student, Rachel Cornacchia, Ifko acts as the facilities manager. The business includes a European-style sport horse breeding program featuring Ifko's current top mount, Un Diamant des Forets, standing as a breeding stallion. Equally successful in the show ring, Un Diamant des Forets made his Canadian Show Jumping Team debut in 2019 in the €200,000 Longines Nations' Cup at CSIO5* Coapexpan, Mexico. The pair went on to enjoy a successful summer circuit in Traverse City, Michigan, where they won the \$133,700 CSI3* Grand Prix and Ifko picked up a \$25,000 leading open jumper rider bonus.

Ifko opened the 2021 season with impressive showings on the Winter Equestrian Festival circuit in Wellington, FL, by capturing two wins and finishing runner-up in the final week's grand prix event.

Eric Lamaze

Birthplace: Montreal, Quebec

Birthdate: April 17, 1968

Hometown: Wellington, Florida

Eric Lamaze made history by becoming the first Canadian equestrian athlete to win an individual Olympic gold medal with Hickstead, considered one of the greatest horses of all time. The incredible accomplishment came two days after Canada won the team silver medal at the 2008 Beijing Olympic Games. By the end of the 2008 season, Lamaze was ranked the number one show jumping rider in the world, a feat he accomplished again in 2010 and 2011.

A three-time Canadian Show Jumping Champion, Lamaze represented Canada in seven consecutive World Equestrian Games (1994, 1998, 2002, 2006, 2010, 2014, and 2018), claiming individual bronze in 2010 where Hickstead was also named "Best Horse." Partnered with Lamaze, Hickstead won every major grand prix title including Calgary (2007 and 2011); Geneva (2008); Aachen (2010); La Baule (2011); and Rome (2011) before his tragic death in November of 2011.

With Coco Bongo, Lamaze led Canada to a team gold medal at the 2015 Pan American Games in Toronto, Canada. At the 2016 Rio Olympics, Canada finished fourth following a jump-off for team bronze while Lamaze and Fine Lady 5 claimed the individual bronze medal.

In March of 2022, Lamaze officially announced his retirement from competition due to ongoing health issues. He has taken the role of Technical Advisor, Jumping with Equestrian Canada and continues to run his large training and horse sales operation, Torrey Pines Stable, with bases in Florida and Belgium.

Vanessa won her first FEI-sanctioned competition in 2015 at CSI3* San Giovanni, Italy, riding Valerie F.S. In 2017, she won the €73,075 CSI4* Grand Prix in Coapexpan, Mexico, before helping Canada finish second in the following week's Nations' Cup riding Grand Cru. Her next Nations' Cup appearance came in 2020 when she and Catinka 25 were members of the Canadian Team at the Winter Equestrian Festival in Wellington, FL.

In addition to riding, Vanessa stays fit with cross-training, tennis, and golf. She enjoys reading and travel, which complements her international show jumping career.

The daughter of 10-time Canadian Olympian Ian Millar, Amy Millar began riding at an early age on the family farm in Perth, ON. Training alongside her father and older brother, Jonathon, Amy has proven that show jumping talent runs in the family.

In 1996, Amy entered the grand prix ranks riding Zagal, the same year she won an individual silver medal at the North American Young Riders' Championship. Exactly 20 years later, Amy made her Olympic debut riding Heros as a member of Canada's fourth-placed team at the 2016 Olympic Games in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil.

With Heros, Amy enjoyed her greatest success to date on the international stage. The pair represented Canada in several Nations' Cup competitions, including in 2016 at CHIO Aachen, Germany, and captured the 2017 Canadian Show Jumping Championship title at the Royal Horse Show in Toronto, ON. Amy's current top horse is Truman, her partner in helping Canada to claim victory in the \$600,000 BMO Nations' Cup during the CSIO5* Spruce Meadows 'Masters' tournament in 2021.

A full-time athlete and trainer at Millar Brooke Farm, Amy holds her Bachelor of Commerce from Toronto's Ryerson University. She and Brad Jukosky are parents to Lily Evelyn Millar Jukosky (2010) and Alexander Millar Jukosky (2018).

Brian Morton's earliest riding memory is a lesson at the age of six on a Shetland pony. An all-round horseman, Brian successfully competed in dressage and three-day eventing before specializing in show jumping at the age of 19. In 2004, Brian won the Western Division of the Jump Canada Talent Squad Series signaling a bright future. He was short-listed to the Canadian Show Jumping Team for the first time in 2012, which was the same year that he was awarded the prestigious \$15,000 North American Riders' Group Grant. In 2016, Brian made his Canadian Show Jumping Team debut in the Nations' Cup of Samorin, Slovakia, riding Atlantis T.

Having operated Equimark Inc. in partnership with Canadian Show Jumping Team veteran, Mark Laskin, for several years, Brian made the move to Calgary, AB, during the 2020 season to ride for Spruce Meadows. His current top horse is Crusador Z, while Firefly W joined his string at the end of the 2021 season.

Sam Walker

As the son of professionals Scott and Dee Walker, Sam grew up riding at the family's Forest Hill Training Centre in Caledon, Ontario. Displaying natural talent from an early age, Sam has been guided in his young career by his parents as well as American-based trainers Missy Clark and John Brennan. In 2018, he topped a starting field of 175 entries riding Waldo to become the fourth Canadian to win the ASPCA Maclay National Championship, considered to be the United States' most prestigious equitation final. Less than a week later, he returned home to win the Running Fox CET Medal National Final at Toronto's Royal Agricultural Winter Fair, having won the Jump Canada Medal Final at The Royal one year earlier.

Sam is also a veteran of North American Youth Championship (NAYC) competition. In 2018, he helped Canada take the team bronze medal in the Junior division. The following year, Sam moved up to the Young Rider division where he led Canada to team gold before claiming the individual silver medal. His partner for both NAYC appearances was Coralissa, owned by Marion and Bill Cunningham's MarBill Hill Farm.

In 2020, Sam made his senior team debut as a member of Canada's fourth-placed team in the \$290,000 Longines Nations' Cup held at the CSIO5* Palm Beach Masters in Wellington, FL, riding Kel'star du Vingt Ponts. With a string of talented mounts, Sam continues to pursue the international levels while also taking advantage of Under 25 competition to further hone his skills.

Eric Lamaze is the most decorated athlete in Canadian equestrian sport history with three Olympic medals – individual gold (2008), team silver (2008) and individual bronze (2016). Lamaze is widely considered one of international show jumping's most successful competitors of all time.

In February of 2022, Lamaze was appointed Technical Advisor, Jumping for Equestrian Canada (EC). The role includes acting as Chair of the Jumping High Performance Advisory Group and Chef d'Equipe of the Canadian Show Jumping Team. While still new to the position, Canada has already accelerated its presence on the international stage under Lamaze's guidance with top finishes in Nations' Cup competition in Wellington, FL; Coapexpan, Mexico; La Baule, France; and Rome, Italy. Team spirit is at an all-time high as Lamaze prepares for the 2022 World Championships in Herning, Denmark.



After stepping into his new role, Lamaze made the difficult decision to retire from competition himself. He continues to operate his large training and horse sales business, Torrey Pines Stable, with bases in Wellington, FL, and Ecaussinnes, Belgium.
